INTRODUCTION

1. EXPLANATION OF THE TWO WILLS OF GOD

- 1.1. Explaining God's will is complicated.
- 1.2. In a sense God has two wills: a sovereign will and a moral will.
 - 1.2.1. God's sovereign (decretive, secret/hidden) will is what He decrees.
 - 1.2.2. God's moral (preceptive, revealed) will is what He commands.
- 1.3. God's sovereign and moral wills overlap.

2. SCRIPTURAL ILLUSTRATIONS OF THE TWO WILLS OF GOD [PIPER]

- 2.1. God willed that Jesus die (Acts 2:23; 4:27–28; Isa 53:4, 10).
- 2.2. God wills the future war against the Lamb (Rev 17:16–17).
- 2.3. God wills to harden peoples' hearts (five examples).
- 2.4. God wills not to restrain evil even though he has the right to restrain evil (two examples).
- 2.5. God wills—even delights in (in one sense)—the punishment of the wicked (Deut 28:63; 2 Sam 2:25).
- 2.6. God wills (in one sense) that *not* all be saved.
